RE

Maths

We will cover the areas of the maths curriculum including place value, four rules, fractions, shape, space and direction as well as using data handling skills in our science lessons.

Science

We will start the term looking at the way organisms adapt to their surroundings and are interdependent on one another. We will then look at evolution and the way living things have changed over time.

After half term we will start our first revision unit – Materials and Their Properties.
