Jane Saunders is an experienced musician and sound therapist. She gives regular Soundbaths which are sessions up to an hour long where one can unwind and let the sound relax the mind, body and spirit. She uses a mixture of toning and instruments such as harp, Himalayan singing bowls, gongs, crystal bowls, and gentle percussion. The sounds are woven into a deeply relaxing surrounding sound which ebbs and flows in tempo and colour. The subtle vibrations pass through the body reducing muscle and nerve pain, lowering blood pressure and heart rate and are also gently energising.
