Year 1 Spring Term Animals



Our topic this term will be Animals, where we will be looking at identifying and naming a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

This will be linked with our Humanities topic of 'Where We Are in the World?' and with our English units of Traditional Tales and Stories from Other Cultures.

Spring 2019

English

We will be reading, re-enacting and writing our own versions of Traditional Tales. Following on from this, we will research some of the animals to write an information text.

Then we'll be moving on to create our own 'counting animals' story books through looking at stories from other cultures. Finally we will end the term by looking at Poetry, learning to recite and perform a poem and write our own Haiku poems about animals.

Science

Animals: The children will learn to identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. They will also learn that animals are either carnivores, herbivores or omnivores.

Seasonal Changes: Children will start to think about the arrival of spring and the changes we notice at this time.

Maths

Number and Place Value: Counting in steps of 5 and 10 to 100. Comparing and ordering numbers, Inverses, Securing Number Facts to 10/20.

Calculation - Learning to add and subtract numbers.

Fractions - recognise and find a half and a quarter of a shape and quantity.

Shapes and Measure - learning to recognise and name 3D Shapes, tell the time to the hour and half past the hour and measure mass.

Problem Solving - across all areas.

Humanities

The topic this term will be Where Are We in the World? The children will learn about the seven continents and the five oceans in the world. They will then go on to look more closely at the British Isles.

Computing

We will be learning how to use the internet safely in order to research facts for our information text.

RE

This term we will study the Epiphany, Revelation, Lent and Holy Week.

Music

Music making will link to our topic.

ART/DT

We will be creating moving pictures of animals, models from clay to link with our science topic and Traditional Tales unit. We will also be looking at patterns in art from other cultures.

SEAL

Our focus for this term will be on Going for Goals and Good to be Me.

PE

Gymnastics and Dance.
