## Spring 2019

### Literacy

Story with a flashback

### Humanities

This term our Humanities focus is on Democracy. We will be studying the Greek dynasty which will include Dikasteria, Boule and Ekklesia - the birth of Democracy. We will then compare it with British democracy. Our topic will also include a detailed understanding of the British values.

### Music

Music and songs since 1945.

### RE

RE teaching follows the Catholic/Christian ethos and values broadly in line with the church liturgical year. Children learn about religious stories and make links between beliefs and actions. They compare their own and other people's ideas and questions that are difficult to answer. This term we will study the Epiphany, Revelation, Lent and Holy Week.

### Computing

This term we will learn to use search technologies effectively. We will appreciate how results can be ranked and that some results are more useful than others.

### ART/DT

We will be studying Lichtenstein, producing work in his unique style. We will also be looking at Graffiti art and the works of Banksy.

### P.S.H.E.

In P.S.H.E. we will be studying 'Going for Goals' and 'Good to be me'. The pupils will also have the opportunity to work with younger children.

### Maths

We will cover the areas of the maths curriculum including place value, ratio and proportion, statistics, algebra, four rules, fractions, shape, space and direction as well as using data handling skills in our science lessons.

### Science

This term we will be studying electricity and the scientists who pioneered its use. Following this we will study light including how it travels and how it enables us to see.

### PE –

The children will continue their games lessons with Mr Toohill. We will also be studying dance and creating our own routines.
