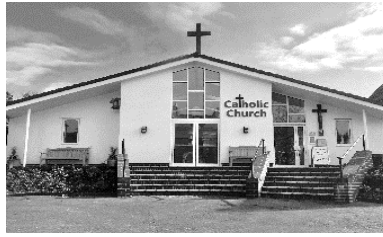

This weekend brings together **Remembrance Sunday** and the centenary of the Armistice of 1918. Mass on the Saturday evening and Sunday morning will be a Mass for Peace, and will include the traditional Act of Remembrance. Deacon Mark will be at our Cathedral in Plymouth on Saturday morning, the 17<sup>th</sup> for a **diocesan celebration of deacons** and the diaconate.

So enjoyable was the recent **Men's Breakfast** that another has been organised before the Advent fast: Saturday the 24<sup>th</sup> at 10:30 at The Bull in East Street, Bridport.

The parish has received a generous **donation of £500** from the family of the late Ron and Agnes Pinkett of Bridport in gratitude for the care they received from our church.

As is our custom here we begin this month a series of nine Requiem Masses, our **November Novena**. All those departed you have asked us to pray for will be remembered at these Masses. Note overleaf the days of these special Masses.

We are going to work towards the creation of a **Prayer Garden** in the redundant piece of land at the back of the Church. Already two parishioners have donated a statue of our Lady and a matching plinth. Faith has a list in the office of items that could be donated in memory of a loved one. Please come to the office if this is something that you would like to do.

We are in desperate need of **one more person to arrange the flowers** in our lovely **Bridport Church**. Full training will be given. This would be on a rota basis about once a month. If you think you can help please see Faith in the office.

The next **CWL meeting** will be on Monday, 12 November 2018, at 2 pm in St John's, Beamminster.

**From the first Sunday in Advent** we will be starting a new **Public Prayer List for the sick, and departed**. From then all requests for names of the sick and departed to be remembered at Mass must be given in through Faith in the Parish Office, and in the case of the sick as far as possible with the permission of that person. This is to bring us into line with the provisions of the new Data Protection laws.

The **new Sunday Missals (£5) and next year's Parish Diaries (50p)** are now available in our churches. The Missals include all that is required for Masses from Advent, beginning on December 2<sup>nd</sup>. If and when you buy a Missal, please put your name inside; over the course of the year we have a number left behind in church with no evidence of ownership
