- A comprehensive timetable of inter-school competition within the Bridport and Beaminster PLT and access to Schools Games Competitions.
- Year 5 and year 6 students have the opportunity to complete leadership programmes which prepare them to be sports ambassadors.
- Regular meetings of PE coordinators to work together organising competitions and offering other sports leagues.
- Opportunities for pupils to experience different activities off the school site.
